Ottawa Regional's Medical Staff specialize in many areas, including primary care, emergency care, general surgery, orthopedics, otolaryngology (ENT), ophthalmology, obstetrics and gynecology, oral surgery, pain management, podiatry, pediatrics, pulmonology, radiation and medical oncology, hematology, psychiatry, cardiology, allergy/immunology, urology, pain management, dermatology, gastroenterology, neurology, nephrology, and thoracic and endovascular therapies.

The Ottawa Regional Campus winds alongside the Fox River. Other hospital facilities on the campus are: a 3-story medical office building that houses both physician and administrative offices; an outpatient mental health building; a medical office building that houses the administrative offices for the hospital's home health and hospice programs, along with a physician office suite and Fresenius Renal Care Center; a 4 physician suite medical office building; Ottawa Regional Medical Center; and the Fox River Cancer Center, in which the hospital is a partner. The hospital also recently constructed a medical office building in nearby Marseilles, IL and owns property on the Southside of Ottawa with future plans to develop that site with physician offices and ancillary services.

Ottawa Regional Medical Center, a physician group, has been providing healthcare services to individuals and families in Ottawa and surrounding areas for more than 50 years. From newborns to seniors and all ages in between, our compassionate and experienced physicians provide the best possible care to you and your family. An addition is presently under construction to expand radiology and lab services and to develop an express care center.
